Take Home Point:

God is powerful—God's power saves us.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba is not afraid to swim because Judy has a lifesaver.
- Bible Event: God's power helps Esther to save her people.
- Craft: We made a party hat.
- Snack: We ate food gifts from our friends.
- Game: We played party games.
- We taught Albie the take home point.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

God helps Queen Esther save her people. (Esther 2 – 9)

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What bad thing was going to happen to the Jews?
- How did God save them?
- What did they do after God helped Queen Esther save her people?
- How does God save us?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)

In Jesus' name. Amen.
