- Option: cut out Appendix B pictures and eliminate safety scissors

- cut from felt or paper: clouds, sun, moon, stars, waves, land, plants, flowers, fish, birds
- stuffed animals of your choice
- tape
- newsprint large enough to make an outline of a child
- black and red markers

Small Group Application

Activity 1: Craft

- Appendix A and B, copied back to back, one per child
- markers (colored pencils also if you want)
- scalloped craft scissors
- stapler
- stickers
- hand wipes

Activity 2: Snack

- napkins, cups, water or juice
- small wax paper squares
- spoon
- white frosting
- for each child: two large marshmallows, five pretzel sticks; two chocolate chips and one red candy

Activity 1: Craft

- Copies of Appendix A and B on different colored cardstock, cut out circles, one copy of each for every two children
- two 3" lengths of ribbon per child
- markers
- glue
- adhesive pin backs or tape and one safety pin per child

Activity 2: Snack

- napkins, cups, water or juice
- 'nuts and bolts' food such as:
 - straight pretzels
 - graham cracker squares
 - mini marshmallows
 - fish crackers

Activity 3: Game

- one pair per team of large shoes
- masking tape

Activity 3: Game

- one gummy worm per child
- two graham cracker sticks or other long thin cookies per child
- paper plates

 - black crayon

- Copy Appendix A on red paper, one per child. Cut out and cut in half on line
- Copy Appendix B (with cross) on white cardstock, one per child
- tape
- crayons or markers

Activity 2: Snack

- napkins, cups, water or juice
- circle cereal
- raisins
- marker

Activity 3: Game

- inflated heart shaped balloon or balloon with heart drawn on with permanent marker
- black washable marker
- wet wipe with cross drawn on with permanent marker
