Take Home Point:

GOD KEEPS HIS PROMISES...I believe God's promises.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba learned that God keeps his promises.
- Bible Event: We had a visit from Abram. He told us how God kept his promises.
- Craft: We made a God Keeps His Promises Picture.
- Snack: We ate Stars in the Sky.
- Game: We played Challenge Impossible.
- We taught Albie the take home point.

- What do you know about God's promises?
- What promise can God's children look forward to God keeping? Why?
