## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns children can help.
- *Bible:* We heard how a little servant girl helped a sick soldier.
- *Snack:* We ate fish crackers because fish live in rivers.
- *Craft:* We made a card to mail to a special friend. It will tell them that God loves them.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Children Help*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Frère Jacques*: "Children can help. Children can help. Everyone. Everyone. Children can help others. Children can help others. Yes, they can. Yes, they can."

## FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. 2 Kings 5

## LEARN BY DOING:

Young children enjoy helping others. Give them simple ways to help: placing napkins on the table, putting dirty clothes in a laundry basket, picking up toys, carrying gifts to neighbors, drawing pictures as gifts of encouragement, helping pull weeds in the garden, taking care of pets, etc.

## TALK ABOUT IT:

- A servant girl helped Naaman.
- Everyone can help others.
- God wants children to help others.

**ECHO PRAYER:** Child repeats each line after adult
