Take Home Point:

Jesus loves me.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy sings *Jesus Loves Me*.
- *Bible:* We heard and acted out Jesus letting the little children come to him.
- *Snack:* We ate a colorful snack of a great mixture of foods while we watched a video.
- *Craft:* We made our own puppet so we can put on puppet shows for our family and friends.
- *Singing:* Tune: *Jesus Loves Me*. "Jesus loves me, this I know. For the Bible tells me so. Little ones to him belong. They are weak, but he is strong. Yes, Jesus loves me. Yes, Jesus loves me. Yes, Jesus loves me. The Bible tells me so."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 19:13-15

LEARN BY DOING:

Jesus loved little children. They were very special to him. Make sure your child knows that he/she is loved more than anything and no matter what they do.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Some disciples tried to keep children from bothering Jesus.
- Jesus blesses children and wants them to come to him.
- Jesus blesses us when we come to him in prayer.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,
We love you.
You gave us Jesus.
Thank you for loving me.
Thank you that I'm special.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
