### This Week's Lesson:

### Take Home Point:

God, our Father, leads us.

### DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns that his daddy can lead him, just like God, our Father, leads us.
- *Bible:* We learned that God our Father made everything...we are more special than birds and flowers.
- *Snack:* We ate crackers that remind us of footsteps.
- *Craft:* We made a card for our daddies.
- *Game:* We followed a path that led all over the room.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "God our Father leads us all, leads us all, leads us all. God our Father leads us all, and daddies lead us, too."

### FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 6:28-34; Exodus 15:13a

### LEARN BY DOING:

Young children learn by example. A father or male figure can have a very positive influence on children. Pray with your child. Take your child to church. Teach your child to be kind to others. Listen to your child. Two year olds have vivid and interesting imaginations.

### TALK ABOUT IT:

- God, our heavenly Father, loves us and leads us as we grow up.
- God has given most of us an earthly father to love us and lead us as we grow up.

### ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,

Thank you for Jesus.  
Thank you for dads.  
Thank you, thank you, thank you.  
In Jesus' name.  
Amen.
