God Chooses Young David

Take Home Point:

God chooses me.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns that God chooses us.
- *Bible:* We heard how God told Samuel to choose young David to be the future king.
- *Snack:* We chose our own snack.
- *Craft:* To remind us that *God chooses me*, we made a wristband to keep and will choose someone to give the other one to.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Which Would You Choose?*
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "God chooses me. God chooses me. I am very special. God chooses me."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. 1 Samuel 16

LEARN BY DOING:

Children need to know that they are special to God and that he chooses them to be his special children. When giving a two-year-old choices with food or toys, use the word "choose." Then remind them that God chose to love them and chose them to be his special children.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- God chooses me, regardless of my young age.
- God uses me because I'm special.
- I can serve God because he has chosen me.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,
We love you.
You choose me.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
