Take Home Point:

Tell others "God loves you."

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba shares today's craft with a bully.
- *Bible:* We learned about and acted out Jonah hiding from God then obeying God.
- *Snack:* We ate a cookie with a heart on it to remind us of God's love.
- *Craft:* We made a TV with a program about God's love.
- *Game:* We played a learning game called *Should you Tell?* and a movement game called *Bean Bag Love*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *The Farmer in the Dell*. "Tell others God loves you. Tell others God loves you. He will take care of you. Tell others God loves you."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Jonah first running away from God then obeying God from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand.
(Jonah 1-3:3)

LEARN BY DOING:

Children role model what we do. Remember to tell others "God loves you" and encourage your child to do the same. Discuss different ways we can show God's love to others... and then do it.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Jonah listened to God and told others about God's love.
- God wants us to tell others about him.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.
