Take Home Point:

Love God. Love others.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy learns about rules.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how God called Moses to the mountain to give him the Ten Commandments.
- Snack: We ate a snack that looked like the stone tablets.
- Craft: We made a bookmark to give to an adult for their Bible.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Loving God, Loving Others?* and a movement game called *Love God, Love Others?*
- Singing: To the tune of: *Row, Row, Row Your Boat*. Love God and love others. Love them every day. We can follow and obey. Love them every day.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Moses and the Ten Commandments from children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Exodus 19 & 20)

LEARN BY DOING:

Compliment your child when he/she does something kind for another. Tell him/her that this is how we love others and how we show our love for God. When we pray, we need to always tell God we love him.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- God gave Moses rules for all of us to follow.
- We can read about God's rules in the Bible.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.
