Take Home Point:

God keeps his promises.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns about promises.
- *Bible:* We acted out God's promises to Noah.
- *Snack:* We ate a rainbow cracker.
- *Craft:* We made a rainbow to remind us of God's promises.
- *Game:* We played a learning game called *Safe Animals* and a movement game called *The Rainbow Game*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *The Farmer in the Dell*. "God keeps his promises. God keeps his promises. He put a rainbow in the sky. God keeps his promises."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Noah and the ark from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Genesis 6-9

LEARN BY DOING:

Use the word "promise" in conversations at home. Talk about how promises are words we say that we will always do. God gave a promise to Noah and left a rainbow to remind everyone that he would never again flood the entire earth. God gives us a promise that he will always love us.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- God kept promises he made to Noah.
- God keeps his promises to us.
- God's promises are in the Bible.
- God promises to always love us.

ECHO PRAYER: (Child repeats each line after adult.)

Dear God,
You are with us.
We love you.
You keep your promises.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
