Take Home Point:

God is our Father.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns about her heavenly Father.
- *Bible:* We learned about and acted out how Jesus gave us a special prayer to say to our father.
- *Snack:* We ate a heart cracker to remind us of our father's love.
- *Craft:* We made a Father's Day card.
- *Game:* We played a learning game called *Can a Father Do This?* and a movement game called *Follow the Leader*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Frère Jacques*: "God's our Father. God's our Father. Yes, he is. Yes, he is. He will love us always. He will love us always. Yes, he will. Yes, he will."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Jesus teaching the *Our Father* from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (*Matthew 6:8-15*)

LEARN BY DOING:

Teach your child the "Our Father" by having them repeat each phrase after you. Do this regularly at night for two weeks to see how much of it they can remember. You will be surprised.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Jesus' father is God.
- God is our heavenly Father and he loves us and leads us.
- God has given some of us earthly fathers who help us grow up.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.

Dear God,

You are with us.

We love you.

You are our Father.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.
