(Kids Say): He lives in me.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN

- Made and ate a Pentecost snack to help review the Bible event.
- Played a balloon game, "Spread the Spirit".

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- We learned how to say "Jesus is alive in five languages.
- We made a heart with lots of flames to represent the Holy Spirit in us.
- Bubba figured out how we know the Holy Spirit is in us.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about how the Holy Spirit came to the disciples in Acts 2:1-13

JESUS LINK:

We believe in Jesus. His Spirit lives with us.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What gift did the disciples receive at Pentecost and how did it change them?
- When we receive Jesus' Spirit, how does he change us?
- How can we share God's Spirit with others?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank God for the gift of his Spirit, the knowledge that Jesus is always with you and the power the Spirit gives you to have faith, be filled with love, and do God's work. Ask God to help you share that gift with others.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

- Make a windstorm. Gather all the fans in the house. Make paper fans. And get ready to blow. How much wind can you make?
- Blow up balloons but do not tie them. Let them go and watch them fly through the air. God's Spirit is more powerful than the strongest windstorm or balloon filled with air and because Jesus gives us his Spirit, we have his power.
