Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Even when we can't see him—

(Kids Say): Jesus is with us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a video of Jesus' ascension.
- Made and ate an "Ascension Snack" to review the Bible event.
- Played a game, "Who's Hiding?" and discussed that even though we cannot see Jesus, we know that he is always with us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Traveler told us how Jesus rode a cloud to heaven but his Spirit stays here with us.
- Taught Bubba that even though we can't see Jesus he is all around us through the people who love us and he is in our heart.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus' Ascension, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Acts 1:1-11.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus is alive in Heaven and his Spirit is here to help us.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What promise did Jesus make before he ascended, went up, to heaven?
- How do we know that Jesus is with us always?
- How can knowing that Jesus is with us always help us?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for being with you always.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Have your child help you make the snack from today's lesson as a special family snack sometime this week. As you eat the snack, have your child review the Bible event. Use this Bible event to remind you child of Jesus' presence when he or she is scared. To make the snack: Lay a teddy graham on a graham cracker and cover with whip cream.
