Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God made my family.

(Kids Say): Thank God, for families.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Participated in an imagination station presentation of the Bible event.
- Made "Nuts and Bolts." A special Father's Day snack, and talked about why fathers are a gift from God.
- Played a game, "Filling Dad's Shoes" relay" and talked about our two fathers—our earthly father and God, our heavenly Father.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Watched a video about families.
- Made crackers look like various sports balls... e.g. baseballs, footballs, soccer balls, basketballs, etc.
- Created a refrigerator magnet to honor dads.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

God Made the First Family, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 1:26-28a and Genesis 2:18-25.

JESUS LINK: Because of Jesus, we belong to God's family.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God make the first family?
- How did God bring you into his family?
- How can you show your family/father you are thankful for them?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank God for the special people in your family.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Show your father, or someone who is like a father to you, that you are thankful to him by doing a favorite activity with him: go fishing, play ball at the park, watch a sports event with him, or go out to his favorite restaurant for dinner.
