DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN

- Made and ate a jelly bean cross.
- Played "Pray to the Cross Relay."

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM CHURCH.

- Heard from Peter, the dramatized character, as he told us about Jesus in the garden.
- Made crackers in to praying hands.
- Played in our own "Prayer Garden."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus Praying in the Garden of Gethsemane, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Matthew 26:36-46.

JESUS LINK:

Just as Jesus prayed to God, we can pray to him as well.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why did Jesus pray in the garden?
- Jesus could have said, "No" to dying on the cross, but he didn't. Why?
- How did God the Father strengthen Jesus?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for dying on the cross for your sins, and ask God the Father to help you with difficult things you must face.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Find a special spot in your yard and designate it as a prayer spot. Put an outdoor bench there, or plant a flower or bush in that spot. If you do not have a yard, designate a special place in your home for prayer. Place a cross in that spot as a reminder of Jesus praying before he went to the cross. Make a practice of praying with your child in the designated spot when troubled times and good times occur.
