DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN

- Played a candy cane relay race as a reminder to share the good news.
- Made an angel snack.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Learned that the shepherds saw the angels then went and saw baby Jesus in the stable.
- Enjoyed a "Baby Jesus" snack made with tortilla and cheese
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FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Shepherds Tell About Jesus, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Luke 2:8-20.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus died for everyone, even those who do not know about him.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why was the shepherd excited in today's Bible event?
- After the shepherds found Jesus and worshipped him, what did they do?
- How can we share the good news that Jesus, our Savior is born?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask God to open your family's eyes for ways to tell that good news of Jesus, our Savior.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Take a walk with your child to deliver the cards in the shepherd's pouch to neighbors. When you are finished, celebrate by having a picnic of hot cocoa and Christmas cookies on a blanket in front of the lighted Christmas tree. Listen to a CD or tape of Christian Christmas music.
