This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Calls His First Disciples

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Jesus is our friend.

(Kids Say): Follow Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Dramatized the story of Jesus calling his first disciples.
- Retold the Bible event using a banana boat and a fish snack.
- Played "Simon Says" as a reminder to follow what Jesus says.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Learned that obeying Jesus' results in big blessings. And, in this case, many fish.
- We caught fish, too... Goldfish cracker fish!
- The presenter told us we could become "fishers " of people for Jesus.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus Calls His First Disciples, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Luke 5:1-11.

JESUS LINK:

We have a personal relationship with our savior, Jesus.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why was Peter afraid of Jesus?
- After the men brought the boat to shore, what did Jesus ask them to do?
- We follow Jesus?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask Jesus to help you follow him all of your lives. Be sure to pray daily for your children, asking God to help them always know, love, and follow him.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Play "Follow the Leader." Take turns being the leader and following each other around the house while moving in different ways—hopping, taking giant steps, tiptoeing, taking baby steps, etc. When you are finished, ask the question, "How can we follow Jesus?"
