**This Week's Lesson:**

**Peter Denies Jesus**

**Take Home Point:**

(Parents Say): Jesus knows my mistakes.

(Kids Say): Jesus forgives me.

## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN  
**KINGDOM QUEST.**

- Watched a dramatized Peter tell the story of Peter denying Jesus.
- Reviewed the Bible event while eating chicken flavored crackers.
- Played a game, "Peter Tell the Truth," and talked about God's forgiveness.

## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN  
**KINGDOM CHURCH.**

- The traveler told us about Peter denying Jesus.
- Created a rooster face with vanilla wafers and various candies.
- Water colors and crayon cross help us see that Jesus' forgiveness shines through.

## **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

Peter Denies Jesus, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Mark 14:66-72.

## **JESUS LINK:**

Jesus has the power to forgive me because he died on the cross in my place.

## **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- What did Peter do that Jesus forgave?
- What are sins do you do?
- Why does Jesus forgive you?

## **PRAYER POWER:**

Tell Jesus for your sins, ask his forgiveness, and thank him for dying on the cross so you can be forgiven.

## **FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:**

Play "Hot or Cold" using a plastic Easter egg filled with jellybeans. Send your child out of the room and hide the egg. When he comes in, have him look for the egg. If he gets near it say "hot." If he is far away, say "cold." After he finds the egg, take turns naming sins you sometimes do for each jellybean in the egg. Thank Jesus that he forgives you and eat the jellybeans. Just as the jellybeans are gone, our sins are gone!
