This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Goes to the Cross

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Jesus is my Savior.

(Kids Say): Jesus died and rose for me.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Listened to a storyteller tell about Jesus dying on the cross.
- Made and ate graham cracker cross.
- Played the game, "Stuck to the Cross."

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM CHURCH.

- The traveler told us about Jesus' death.
- Fingerpainted with chocolate pudding on white paper.
- Bubba, the puppet, showed us sin and how Jesus forgives our sins.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus' Death on the Cross, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Luke 22:33, 44-56.

JESUS LINK:

Because of Jesus' death, we now have power over death.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why was Jesus dying on the cross sad?
- Why was it happy?
- What sins of yours did Jesus nail to the cross?

PRAYER POWER:

Turn off the lights in a dark room and sit in a circle holding hands. Take turns telling God one sin you have done and asking him to forgive you. Thank God that you can be forgiven because Jesus died to take the punishment for those sins.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Take a walk outside looking for twigs shaped like crosses. As you do, review the story of Jesus dying on the cross. At home place the twigs on your home altar. If you do not find any twigs shaped like a cross, hot glue two twigs together to form a cross.
