DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Participated in an Imagination Station titled "Doing for the Least of These."
- Sorted out a snack to review the Bible event.
- Played a game, "Red, Green, Chase, Run" and discussed how and why Jesus will sort out the people at the end of the world and how we can share Jesus' love with others.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Ate animal crackers to remind us of the sheep and the goats.
- Made "encouragement" cards to give away.
- Played "Sheep, sheep, goat."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

About the Sheep and the Goats, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Matthew 25:31-46.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus shared his life with me.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What was the greatest thing Jesus shared with us?
- Why should we share with others?
- How can we share with others?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for sharing his life on the cross for you and ask him to help you serve him by sharing with and serving others.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

In today's Bible event, the children learned that whatever we do for others, we do it also for Jesus. Encourage your children to serve, share, and show love to others and Jesus with "loving hearts." Have the children do nice things such as giving a hug, picking up a toy, or throwing away garbage for other people. Have them either leave a heart (sticker, candy, or cut out heart) or give it to the person and say, "Jesus loves you and so do I!"
