*Attention Grabber for Worship:*

*Attention Grabber for Theme:*

- telephone

*Bible Presentation:*

- three loaves of bread
- plastic fish
- rubber snake

- egg
- plastic scorpion (*optional*)
- malted milk balls

*Learning Game:*

- ten malted milk balls in a container for each group of ten kids
- ten malted milk balls in a bowl
- “Blessing Machine” that dispenses malted milk balls. Essentially, this is a large box or freestanding divider that has a tube coming out of it. For the tube, use whatever’s handy. One great suggestion is one of those flexible plastic tubes that are used to make noise by spinning them over one’s head. Other options might be a cardboard tube, PVC, or marble roller.
- foil wrapped malted milk ball hidden carefully in or around a door where, if there were some kind of knocking, it would come loose. For example, the malted milk ball could be in a box above the door that when knocked on, the candy would fall.
- malted milk ball for each child

*Application:*

- sign that reads “WHY?” on one side and “WHO!” on the other side

- a bucket for each group
- eight-foot ladder with a poster board or cardboard trough taped to the top—this trough will be angled so an egg might be rolled off and land in a consistent spot

*Option 2:*

- newspaper-covered tables
- plastic tubs

- scissors
- one hard-boiled egg

*Introduction to Bible Presentation:*

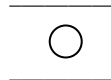

## **Luke 2:1-20**

1. At that time the Emperor Augustus ordered a census of the Roman Empire. This was the first census taken while Quirinius was governor of Syria. All the people went to register in the cities where their ancestors had lived.

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2. So Joseph went from Nazareth, a city in Galilee, to a Judean city called Bethlehem. Joseph, a descendant of King David, went to Bethlehem because David had been born there. Joseph went there to register with Mary. She had been promised to him in marriage and was pregnant.

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3. While they were in Bethlehem, the time came for Mary to have her child. She gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him in strips of cloth and laid him in a manger because there wasn't any room for them in the inn.

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4. Shepherds were in the fields near Bethlehem. They were taking turns watching their flock during the night.
