Check for items you may have on hand and adapt as needed. You may be able to use videos from your city library, video rental store, and members of your congregation or other churches.

Lesson 1

Attention Grabber:

- an item from presenter's home with significant meaning

The Power of the Cross:

- paper table tent with the word "sin," on it

Offering:

- plate or basket

Learning Game:

- Game 1 supplies: tape lines on the floor, burlap bags or a substitute such as old pillowcases
- Game 2 supplies: tape
- Game 3 supplies: spoons and Ping Pong balls (or alternative)

Bible Reading:

- invited guests

Lesson 2

Power of the Cross:

- large cutout star with a masking tape backing

Learning Game:

- bite-size candy or small candy bars per child
- ball (optional)
- music, horn, or noisemaker

Application:

- video, *You are Special* by Max Lucado—available from www.christianbooks.com in VHS format (\$9.99) or in DVD from Thomas Nelson (ISBN #14003003435 for \$12.99—book included)
- “The Secret of Greatness” from Max Lucado’s *Tell Me the Secrets* (Wheaton, Illinois: Crossway Books, 1993)
- six stars and six dots that could be stuck to a child’s clothing—these could perhaps be backed with masking tape

Lesson 3

Attention Grabber:

- three or four objects or toys that are used by friends together (for example rollerskates, a basketball, and a phone)
- shepherd’s staff

Offering:

- one of the toys from the Attention Grabber

Learning Game:

- flat bed sheet for each group
- dozens of eggs
- paper towels and wet wipes for clean up

Application:

- *Application 1: “Tasting Contest”*
- nine paper plates numbered one through nine
- nine blindfolds
- nine different food items. They can include items like graham crackers, broccoli, a ball of macaronis, a mild onion slice, apple slice, etc.
- plate with something that is absolutely yucky, such as a rotten banana peel or some other spoiled food
- mini candy bars
- *Application 2: “A Walk With Jesus”*
- enough hard candies for each kid

Lesson 4

Attention Grabber:

- picture of presenter as a child
- picture of his/her son or daughter

The Power of the Cross:

- baptismal font

Learning Game:

- two cans of cheese spread in a can, or two cans of shaving cream for sensitive skin
- two containers of cereal rings
- two containers of cheese puffs
- two containers of cheese crackers
- two chairs
- two dividers
- father/daughter and father/son team
- four sheets
- towels
- room divider

Application 2: (An option, if video is not shown.)

- clear milk bottle or another bottle with a neck circumference slightly smaller than an egg
- hard-boiled egg without its shell
- match

- a thick book
- some type of small idol (a little Buddha, a crystal, or a plastic animal)

- cross

Learning Game:

- obstacle course in the room using hula hoops or some other kind of markers that are safe if children step into them or bump against them
- two to five inflated balloons

Attention Grabber:

- blanket

- (optional) purse

Offering:

- blanket

Learning Game:

- two hula hoops per fifteen children

Lesson 7

Attention Grabber:

- heavy set of barbells that a kid could not lift
- globe

The Power of the Cross:

- barbells
- firefighter's hat

Offering:

- barbell or weight

Learning Game:

- cassette player
- cassette with active music
- potato for every six kids

Application 2:

- 4 x 4-inch piece of paper
- knife
- potato
- nonpermanent marker

Lesson 8

The Power of the Cross:

- overhead projector
- overhead transparency
- marker for writing on transparency

Learning Game:

- masking tape
- folded newspaper torn in half
- eggs
- chair
- large garbage bags to cover the floor

Attention Grabber:

Lesson 10

Attention Grabber:

- three award ribbons, marked first, second, and third (These can be made or used the attached appendix. Old trophies could even be brought from home to provide visual aid.)

Offering:

- first and second place ribbons
- offering plate

Learning Game:

- blown up and tied off balloon for each child
- tape or string to tie balloon to the child's ankle

Lesson 11

Attention Grabber:

- Valentine card or a present

Offering:

- red paper heart to be placed in offering basket

Learning Game:

For each group of five kids:

- large sheet of newsprint
- markers
- masking tape
- scissors
- darts (If darts are too expensive or unavailable, thumbtacks can be taped to a ball.)

Lesson 12

Offering:

- two pennies

Learning Game:

- overhead projector
- transparency with the word “**LIE**” should be printed in large type; next to this word have “lie” printed in very small type
- Veggie Tales movie, *Larry Boy and the Fib From Outer Space* produced by Big Idea Productions

Attention Grabber:

- -binoculars

Learning Game:

- paper and pencil for every ten kids
- hoses and funnels (optional)

Learning Game:

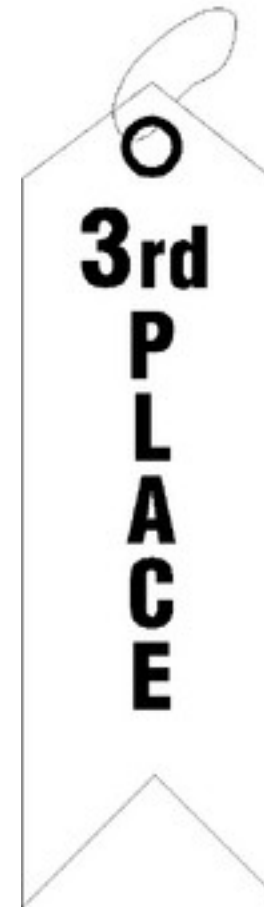
- penny candy in a large glass jar (Be sure you know the number of candies in the jar.)
