Lesson 49

Power of the Cross:

- cross (not a crucifix)

Offering:

- basket or plate

Learning Game:

- ten medium-sized rocks that fit comfortably in a child's hand

Bible Presentation:

- video of *The Gospel of John*, produced by Visual Bible International—order from www.visualbible.com
- five or six rocks (refrigerated, but keep one out for warmth)
- bag for mixing the rocks
- chairs placed next to each other or a couch

Witness and Tell:

- a rock for each child

Attention Grabber:

- bucket or towel to muffle a voice

Offering:

- globe or object representative of your church's mission project

Learning Game:

- three long socks or strips of cloth

- two words on a sign: “avail” and “ability” (written so when held together they spell “availability”)

Attention Grabber:

- a Mother's Day chocolate candy
- a flower
- a Mother's Day card

Offering:

- hula hoop

Learning Game:

- bucket for each group of eight
- wrapped chocolate candy, one per child

Bible Presentation:

- make a small time machine using supplies within your classroom—for example: use a chair, a music stand as a control panel, a box, or table
- the book *Love You Forever* written by Robert Munsch—order from <http://www.amazon.com/exec/obidos/ASIN/0920668364/griefnet>

Application:

- a Mother's Day card printed on cardstock for each child (see appendix page)
- magazines
- scissors
- glue
- markers or crayons
- extra pieces of 8½ by 11-inch paper

Power of the Cross:

- hand-held cross

Offering:

- rope or tape to make a large circle on the floor

Bible Presentation:

Option 1:

- *The Animated Stories of the Bible: Daniel*, produced by Nest Family Entertainment—order from www.nestfamily.com. Go to the menu on the left side and link to Children's Bible Stories. Type the word "Daniel" in the search box and enter. Following the ordering instructions.

Option 2:

- volunteer dressed in khaki shirt and safari hat
- *option*: a whip and chair

Attention Grabber:

- bag prepared for the illusion (see appendix)
- oyster crackers
- a paper cross cut out and placed in the bottom of the sack with the crackers

Power of the Cross

- sack from *Attention Grabber*

Offering:

- paper sack

Learning Game

- plastic clothespins
- kite string
- one chair for each team
- paper plate
- pieces of bread
- baby wipes (optional)

Bible Presentation:

Option 1:

- Show the video *Animated Stories from the Bible: Elijah* (Nest Family Entertainment Network, 1993). The running time is 16 minutes and 46 seconds. Stop the video when you see Elijah walking in front of the hot sun and wiping his brow. Order from www.nestfamily.com. Link to Children's Bible Stories in the left margin. Type in "Elijah" in the search box. Order as instructed.

Option 2:

- a costumed adult presents the Bible Event, telling it from the first person point of view
- chair with a sheet over it to look like a rock
- blue tarp or plastic table cloth on the floor to look like a river

Attention Grabber:

- a dollar bill
- a thick book
- some type of small idol (a little Buddha, a crystal, or a plastic animal)

- cross

Learning Game:

- obstacle course in the room using hula hoops or some other kind of markers that are safe if children step into them or bump against them
- two to five inflated balloons

Application:

Option 1:

- video from Nest Family Entertainment, *Animated Stories From the Bible: Elijah* (Nest Family Entertainment Network, 1993)—order from www.nestfamily.com. Link to Children's Bible Stories in the left margin. Type in "Elijah" in the search box and enter. Order as instructed.

Option 2:

- box for an altar
- sticks
- wadded up paper for rocks
- two pretend slabs of meat
- costumes for King Ahab and Elijah
- flash paper
- microphone for announcer
- four empty milk jugs or pitchers

Attention Grabber:

- option: a head piece or costume, picture, or any related prop to represent the three characters: Superman, Spiderman and Elisha

- two small plastic bags
- two shower caps
- a plastic tarp or tablecloth

Directions for illusion

Take two large paper sacks. Cut out the bottom of one bag, leaving a small lip approximately one-half inch in size on the short side.



Fold the lip down and tape it to the inside of the other paper bag.



This will create a false bottom.
