This Week's Lesson:

The Runaway Son

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God always forgives.

(Kids Say): Tell God you're sorry.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched "Prodigal Son" video.
- Played the "Broken Heart" game.
- Had a "Forgiveness Party."

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Heard the story of the Prodigal Son from a visit by "The Traveler."
- Played the parachute game "Gone & Back." as a reminder that we can always run back to God.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Prodigal Son, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Luke 15:11-32.

JESUS LINK:

Because Jesus died for us, God forgives us.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What did the runaway son do wrong in the story?
- How do you think the runaway son felt when his father forgave him?
- How do you feel when you tell God the things you do wrong and he forgives you?

PRAYER POWER:

Tell Jesus the things you did wrong today and ask him to forgive you.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Inflate a balloon. Use a permanent marker to write on the balloon some of the things your family does wrong. Draw a cross on the balloon. Remind your child that Jesus died on the cross to forgive our sins. Cover your ears and pop the balloon. Explain that just as the balloon is gone, when we are forgiven, our sins are gone. Inflate a couple more balloons and bop them around to celebrate God's forgiveness.
