DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.**

- The Traveler told how Paul taught Lydia about Jesus.
- We acted out ways to be kind to others with puppets and felt.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The conversion of Lydia, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Acts 16:11-15.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus proved his kindness by dying for our sin.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did Lydia come to faith in Jesus?
- How do we come to faith in Jesus?
- How can we share the Good News of Jesus with others?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for showing his love for you by dying on the cross. Ask Jesus to help you share that love by being kind to others and by sharing the news of Jesus with them.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Go to a dollar store and pick up several items to put in a "kindness box" (gift box, basket or decorative bag). Add some candies and a note that says, "Jesus loves you and so do we!" Deliver the kindness box secretly to a neighbor or friend.
