This Week's Lesson:
God Frees the Israelites

Take Home Point:
(Parents Say) God saves us from enemies.
(Kids Say) Follow God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a video of God freeing the Israelites from slavery in Egypt through the ten plagues.
- Made and ate "Unleavened Cinnamon and Sugar Tortillas" as a reminder that the Israelites ate unleavened bread. We also are to be ready to follow God.
- Played a game, "Follow Moses; Follow God Charades" as a review of the Bible event.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Heard the Bible event from "the Traveler."
- Ate trail mix to understand that the Israelites had to have food quick to eat.
- Made a fold-up booklet telling about the plagues that came upon Egypt because Pharaoh was so stubborn.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

"God Frees the Israelites" from an early reader Bible or read and summarize Exodus 7:14-12:50.

JESUS LINK: Jesus saved us from our greatest enemy—sin.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God free the Israelites from slavery in Egypt?
- How did God save us from slavery to sin?
- What are some enemies we can trust God to save us from?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask Jesus to forgive you of your sins and to help you follow God by trusting in him.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS: Plan a family outing such as going to a park, the zoo, or swimming. Keep it a secret when you will go and tell your children they must be ready to leave at any time. Suddenly, announce it is time to leave. On the way to the outing, compare your trip to the Israelites leaving Egypt at a moment's notice. In the same way, God sometimes asks us to follow him suddenly. He may ask us to follow him by comforting someone who is sad, asking for his peace when we are afraid, or asking him to help us resist temptations to sin.
