DRIVE TIME HOME

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Created our faces on sugar cookies.
- Dressed-up like moms and dads in their various occupations.
- Made faces on balloons to show individuality and special-"ness."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

God Made Man, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 1:26-27, 2:7, 21-22.

JESUS LINK: Through Jesus all things were made, including me.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God make the world and the things in the world?
- How did God make people?
- How did God make you special?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank God for the ways in which he made you special and for his love for you.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Look through some old family photo albums and recall some favorite memories. Point out special attributes of your child as you look at the photos. For example, "You sure were a happy baby; God blessed you with a big smile." Or, "God gave you a wonderful imagination. Even as a toddler you loved to pretend." Thank God for the ways in which your child is special.
