This Week's Lesson:

People's First Sin

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say) Tell God your sins.

(Kids Say) God forgives us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Listened to a tandem storytelling of Adam and Eve eating the forbidden fruit.
- Made and ate "Amazing Mud," compared sins to mud' and learned that Jesus died on the cross to forgive our sins and lift us out of the mud.
- Played "Simon Says" and learned that even one sin separates us from God, but Jesus brings us forgiveness.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Watched a video about the first sin.
- Compared real oranges (good for us) and candy orange slices (not so good for us), and talked about how sin tempts us.
- Made a puzzle from our coloring page.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

"People's First Sin" from an early reader Bible or read Genesis 3:1-24 and summarized it.

JESUS LINK:

God sent Jesus to forgive us of all our sins.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What was the first sin?
- What are some sins that we do?
- Why can we be forgiven?

PRAYER POWER:

Confess or tell Jesus your sins and ask him to forgive you. Ask God to help you "go and sin no more."

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Let your child help you pick out some of his or her favorite fruit and make a fruit salad. Review the story of Adam and Eve eating the forbidden fruit. Top the fruit with whip cream as a reminder that because Jesus forgives us our sins, we will someday be with God in heaven and everything will be perfect.
