This Week's Lesson:

Manna and Quail

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say) Stop complaining.

(Kids Say) God will take care of us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Made a table tent that reminds us that we don't need to complain because God will take care of us.
- Ate cereal to remind us that God gave manna to the hungry Israelites.
- Played a game to reinforce the Bible event of God's people gathering manna.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Ate pita bread to remind us of the manna God provided.
- Decorated our "quail" to remind us that God provided meat for the Israelites.
- Played "Complaint Land" to help us remember the take home point, *STOP COMPLAINING – *God will take care of us.*

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

About the Manna and the Quail in an early reading Bible or from Numbers 11:4-34.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus is bread from heaven. We can trust him and he fills our hearts with his love.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What were the two things God gave the Israelites when they said they were hungry?
- On the seventh day, the Israelites couldn't gather manna. How much did they gather on the sixth day?
- What can we do instead of complaining?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask God to forgive you for complaining. Seek things to thank him for.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

If the weather permits, take a picnic to the park. Over the meal, consider all the different ways God has taken care of you.
