Take Home Point:

(Parents Say) God saves us from danger.

(Kids Say) Trust God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Made a rainstorm and helped Bubba learn that we can trust God.
- Watched a movie, "The Story of Noah's Ark."
- Ate a snack, "Mix and Match Animal Snack" and learned that God saved the animals too.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Helped act out Noah's ark and all the animals that came on board.
- Ate graham crackers with blue frosting and an orange slice to represent the ark floating on water.
- Colored a rainbow to remember God's promise of no more world floods.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

"God Sends a Flood" from an early reader Bible or read and summarize Genesis 6 and 7.

JESUS LINK:

God saved Noah through a wooden boat; Jesus saved us through a wooden cross.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why did God send a flood?
- Why did God save Noah and his family?
- How does God save us from danger?

PRAYER POWER:

Tell God the things that frighten you and ask him to help you trust him to protect you.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Run through the sprinklers outside. Recall how God safely brought Noah through the floodwaters. What problems has God safely brought your family through?
