Take Home Point:

(Parents Say) God leads us to safety.

(Kids Say) Thank God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a video of God parting the Red Sea.
- Reviewed the Bible event while eating a snack of either "Moses' Staff" or "Praise Shakers."
- Played a game, "Impossible Water Challenge," to learn that God saves us from the impossible—especially our sins.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Acted out the parting of the Red Sea during the telling of the Bible event.
- Created our own Red Sea craft of cardstock and blue streamers.
- Played a version of "Red Light, Green Light." Our Moses used his staff when he said, "Open, Sea" or "Close, Sea."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

"The Israelites Cross the Red Sea" from an early reader Bible or read and summarize Exodus 13:17-15:21.

JESUS LINK:

Just as God rescued the Israelites, God rescues us through Jesus.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God rescue the Israelites?
- What problems do we face?
- How does God rescue us?

PRAYER POWER:

Tell God any problems you are facing and ask him to help you.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Drive through town and look for signs of "rescue heroes"—fire trucks, police station, hospitals, etc. After your drive, stop for ice cream somewhere and talk about why we can call God the greatest rescue hero ever.
