- Remembered a rhythm by following the leader and using percussion instruments.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Last Supper, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Matthew 26:20-30.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus spends every moment caring for us: he even spent his last night on earth with his disciples.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why was Jesus happy in the Bible event? Why was he sad?
- What do the bread and the wine from the Lord's Supper remind us about?
- Why did Jesus die for us?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for the Lord's Supper and that you can always remember that he died for you and that he lives inside you.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Look through a family photo album together as a family, remembering some of your happiest events. When you are finished, have each person remember one favorite Bible story about Jesus.
