DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN

- Participated in a drama of Jesus feeding the 5,000.
- Reviewed the story with a fishy snack.
- Played a bowling game to differentiate between wants and needs.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- The traveler illustrated the miracle of feeding the 5,000 by feeding us.
- When we played house, we identified things in our house by indicating which were wants and needs.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus Feeds 5,000, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Luke 9:10-17, John 6:1-15.

JESUS LINK:

We can pray to Jesus anytime: he is always ready to listen and answer us.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- In the Bible event, what did the people need? How did Jesus help them?
- What are some things we need?
- When we need something, what can we do?

PRAYER POWER:

Walk through your home and decide which things are things you need and which are things you want. Thank God for giving you everything you own. Most importantly, thank him for giving you Jesus to die for you.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Hang up two manila envelopes. One should be labeled "need" and one should be labeled "want." When your child wants you to buy something, have her draw or cut out a picture of the item. Help her decide if it goes in the "need" envelope or the "want" envelope. Each time this happens, stop and say a brief prayer thanking God for the many things he has already given you.
