DRIVE TIME HOME

- Sang "Happy Birthday to Jesus" and ate a birthday snack cake.
- Had a treasure hunt to find the true gift of Christmas.

DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.**

- Learned that Jesus' is God's gift to the world.
- Put on our imagination hats and heard about Jesus' birth
- Made a birthday card for Jesus on butcher paper.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus Is Born, from an early reading Bible, or read the event from Luke 2:1-7.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus left a perfect heaven to become human in an imperfect world.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- In the Bible event, what exciting news did Joseph have to tell?
- What is the best gift of Christmas? Why?
- How can we celebrate Jesus' birthday in our house?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for being born on the first Christmas. Thank Jesus for being your Savior. Have each family member tell Jesus one thing they have done wrong and ask Jesus to forgive them. Sing "Happy Birthday to Jesus."

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Make simple baby Jesus ornaments. Glue pieces of white cloth or wrap sticky back felt onto old-fashioned clothespins or craft sticks. Draw a face on them and glue a loop of pipe cleaner to the back. Hand out these ornaments to neighbors, friends, acquaintances, or even people at the store, post office, or other places you visit and say, "Jesus is the gift of Christmas! Merry Christmas!"
