Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God keeps his promises.

(Kids Say): I wait patiently.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Dramatized the story of the birth of Isaac.
- Waited patiently for a sand timer to run down before getting an additional snack treat and discussed waiting patiently for God's promises.
- Played a game and reviewed the event.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Watched a video regarding the birth of Isaac.
- Ate a snack that represented baby Isaac wrapped in a blanket.
- Made a craft with coffee filters.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Isaac's Birth, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 18: 1-15, 21:1-3.

JESUS LINK:

We wait patiently to see Jesus face to face.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why did Sarah laugh? What did God do?
- Name some promises that God has kept.
- What is a promise that we wait patiently for God to keep?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank God for always keeping his promises, especially the promise to send a Savior, Jesus. Ask him to help you wait patiently to see Jesus face to face in heaven.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Make a promise to have a family fun night. Choose a favorite family game or a video for the fun night. Set up the game or get the video ready, then set a timer for several minutes and make your children sit quietly until the timer rings. Just as they had to wait for the timer to ring, we must sometimes wait for God to keep his promises. But he always keeps them—and that's a promise!
