Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God keeps his promises.

(Kids Say): I believe God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.**

- Listened to a person dressed as Abram recall the story of when God promised him children and land.
- Made and ate a "Stars in the Sky" snack.
- Played an "Impossible Challenge" game to learn that Jesus is the fulfillment of God's promise to send a Savior to do the "impossible."

DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.**

- Through some craft tricks, we saw stars that illustrated God's promise to Abraham.
- Made our own star lit sky with sponges, paint and construction paper.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

God Promises Abraham Children and Land, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 15:1-7.

JESUS LINK:

I believe, because of Jesus, God will keep his promise to take me to heaven.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What did God promise Abram?
- What do you know about God's promises?
- What promise can God's children look forward to God keeping? Why?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank God for keeping his promise to send a Savior. Thank God that he will someday keep his promise to take you to heaven because of Jesus. Ask God to help you keep your promises.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Make a promise to your children to do a special family activity this week, such as visiting the zoo or going hiking. Plan when the promise will be kept. As you drive to the activity, review the Bible event and remind your children that God always keeps his promises.
