DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Had a visit from the Traveler who told us the story of the unmerciful servant.
- Ate popcorn to show ratio of our forgiveness to God's.
- Made refrigerator magnets.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Forgive Us Our Debts, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Matthew 18:21-35.

JESUS LINK:

God forgives us because Jesus paid for our debts on the cross.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What did the king do to the servant with a large debt?
- What did that servant do to another servant who owed him a small debt?
- What does God do about your sins? What will you do about others who sin against you?

PRAYER POWER:

Make a nightly habit of repenting of your sins and asking God to forgive them, as well as asking God to help you forgive those who have wronged you during the day.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Put a bowl on the kitchen table and get a couple rolls of pennies. Each time someone forgives a family member, drop a penny in the bowl. When all the pennies are in the bowl, give the money to church as a thanks offering to God for forgiving all your sins.
