Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Even in tough times.

(Kids Say): God rescues me.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a video of Joseph interpreting Pharaoh's dreams.
- Ate Corn Pops and Rice Krispies while reviewing the Bible event.
- Played a musical game, "A Famine's Coming to Egypt's Land" and talked about how God rescues us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Ate half of a banana and dipped it in Rice Krispies to look like a grain stalk.
- Created a corn stalk out of newspaper to remind us of the Bible event.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Pharaoh's Dream, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 39:20, 41:15-40.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus rescued me from sin when he died on the cross.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God rescue Joseph?
- How does God rescue us?
- What is the greatest way in which Jesus has rescued us?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank God for rescuing you from problems, especially the problem of sin.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Draw a large outline of a cross and post it on the refrigerator or a wall. Over the next week, every time your child sins and you forgive him or her, write the sin on the cross and thank Jesus for rescuing your family from sins.
