## DRIVE TIME HOME

## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN  
**KIDS CHURCH.**

- Watched "Jacob" tell his story of deceiving his dad.
- Ate snacks out of a paper bag.
- Drew pictures of Jacob.

### **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

Jacob Tricks Isaac, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 27:1-41, 28:5.

### **JESUS LINK:**

Because Jesus gave his life for me, I am forgiven.

### **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- What sins did Jacob do and what happened because of his sins?
- How do you sometimes sin?
- How did God show us that he loves us, even though we sin?

### **PRAYER POWER:**

Tell God your sins. Thank him for loving you even when you sin and for forgiving you because of Jesus.

### **FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:**

Jacob had smooth skin. Esau had hairy skin. Take a texture walk to feel the different textures around the house. How many textures did you find? Review the Bible event of Jacob tricking Isaac. What sins have you done? Tell them to Jesus and remember God's love and forgiveness!
