Jacob's Dream

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Even in tough times.

(Kids Say): God never leaves me alone.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched "Jacob" retell and act out God coming to him in a dream.
- Made and ate an angel snack while reviewing the Bible event.
- Played a game and talked about how it makes us feel to know God is with us always.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Listened to an echo pantomime of Jacob and his dream.
- Ate chocolate pudding and discussed how God is always with us.
- Made angles out of triangles and hearts.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jacob's Dream, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 28:10-22.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus is with me always.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why was Jacob afraid? How did God comfort Jacob?
- What are some hard times you have in your life?
- How does God comfort you?

PRAYER POWER:

As you are doing different activities, such as eating, playing, doing chores, and going to bed, stop and thank God for being with you.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Color a number of craft sticks and glue them into cross shapes. Hang them (tape them) or hide them in various places around the house and in the car. Whenever you see one, it can serve as a reminder that "wherever you go and whatever you do, Jesus is there with you."
