Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Even in tough times.

(Kids Say): God keeps me safe.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a video of Joseph being sold into slavery.
- Made a well with water and had water and animal crackers for snack while reviewing the Bible event.
- Played "Joseph's Coat of Many Colors Relay" and named tough times when God is with us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- "Joseph" told the story of being sold to Egyptians.
- Ate graham crackers with colorful candies to represent Joseph's colorful robe.
- Made "Sit Upsons" with material and large Ziploc bags.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Joseph is Sold by His Brothers, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 37:12-36

JESUS LINK:

Jesus died and rose again so he will be with us always.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God keep Joseph safe in tough times?
- What are some of your tough times?
- How does God keep you safe in tough times?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank God for keeping you safe in tough times.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Start a journal to remind your family of how God has helped you in tough times. Children can draw pictures of the tough times and parents can write a sentence or two explaining how God helped in those times. Update the journal frequently and review it occasionally as a reminder of God's strength in your lives.
