This Week's Lesson:

The Fall of Man

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God keeps his promises.

(Kids Say): I trust his forgiveness.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Listened to a costumed Adam tell about his fall into sin.
- Dipped apple slices in a sweet dip and reviewed the Bible event while eating them.
- Played a game and talked about how Adam and Eve upset things with their sin.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Watched the video, *The Beginner's Bible: The Story of Creation*.
- Ate applesauce and added cinnamon to illustrate sin.
- Listened to the puppets tell about sin.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Adam and Eve's Fall into Sin, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 3.

JESUS LINK:

All have sinned—forgiveness comes through Jesus.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What happened when Adam and Eve sinned?
- How do you sin?
- Why, when you sin, can you be forgiven?

PRAYER POWER:

Tell God the sins you did today and ask him to forgive you.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Put a favorite small candy in front of your child. Tell him you need to leave for a minute, but your child must not eat the candy. Walk out of the room for a few moments and then come back in. If your child has not eaten the candy, give him a small bag of the candy to eat. If he has eaten the candy, only give him a couple more. Explain that God's rules are like that. It's hard to obey them sometimes, but God has something better for us even though we don't always know what. Stress how wonderful it is that God forgives us when we sin and he always loves us.
