Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God's creation is grrreat!

(Kids Say): God made me!

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Observed a mystery box presentation of the Bible event.
- Made and ate a marshmallow and pretzel person and reviewed the Bible event.
- Played a game called "Created to Move," and discussed the many things God created us to be able to do.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Made "people" out of pretzels and treats.
- Saw the creation story in felt.
- Read books on creation in the Reading Zone.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

God Created Man and Woman, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 2:7, 15, 18-24.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus makes me a new creation.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God create Adam and Eve?
- In what ways has God made you special?
- What happened to make God's creation less than perfect? How does Jesus make us a new creation?

PRAYER POWER:

Bless your child through prayer. Lay your hands on him and thank God for the many ways he has made your child special. Name specific things such as a bright smile, a joyful attitude, a loving heart, or an abundance of energy.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Let your children know how glad you are God created them. Take them somewhere special for some one-on-one time. For example, go out for ice cream, go to the park, or go for a hike in the woods. Be sure to tell your child that you are thankful God has blessed you with him.
