**Take Home Point:**

(Parents Say): Even in tough times.

(Kids Say): God makes good things happen.

## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN  
**KINGDOM QUEST.**

- Watched a video of Joseph forgiving his brothers.
- Tasted sour lemonade and sweet lemonade. We talked about God turning the sour times into something sweet.
- Played a game and talked about how God can make our tough times good.

## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN  
**KIDS CHURCH.**

- Ate our pudding snack with crushed cookies.
- Created a cross with many pieces of torn colored paper.
- Colored the page showing Joseph forgiving his brothers.

## **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

Joseph Forgives His Brothers, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Genesis 42:1-3, 45:3-28, 50:20.

## **JESUS LINK:**

Jesus' troubles on the cross were for our good.

## **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- What tough times did Joseph have?
- How did God turn his tough times into good?
- What tough times has God turned into good in our family?

## **PRAYER POWER:**

Thank Jesus for going through a tough time on the cross so that you can be forgiven and go to heaven. Tell God a tough time you are going through now and ask him to turn it into good.

## **FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:**

Have your child do a tough task such as cleaning out the closet in his or her bedroom. Lend a hand and when you are finished, celebrate with an ice cream sundae. As you eat, tell your child a story of a tough time in your life that God used for good.
