DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN

- Ate bread and jam while reviewing the Bible event and learned a new song prayer.
- Played a game, "Good News Megaphone Relay" to practice telling others about Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Watched a video that told the story of Easter.
- Made roads in the sand to help us remember about the men on the road to Emmaus.
- Wrote the name of "JESUS" on our craft.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Road to Emmaus, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Luke 24:13-35.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why were the men sad as they walked along the road?
- When Jesus appeared to them, what did he tell them?
- After Jesus was gone, the men shared the news with others. How can we share the news of Jesus with others?

JESUS LINK:

Jesus died and rose for everyone—share the Good News.

PRAYER POWER:

Pray for someone you know who needs to learn about Jesus. Ask Jesus to help you tell others about him.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Today your child brought home a bag of "Jesus is Alive! Cards." Help your child hand out these cards to neighbors, friends and relatives who need to know about Jesus.
