DRIVE TIME HOME

- Played a relay game, "Stuff Mom's Bag," to teach appreciation for all the things mothers do for their children.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KIDS CHURCH.

- Discussed the different ways moms comfort their children.
- Prepared treats to take home to mom.
- Made a card or treat bag to take home to mom on her special day.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse: Isaiah 66:13

JESUS LINK: Jesus gives us families to care for us.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What are some of the ways moms care for us?
- Does God comfort us?
- How does God show his love to us?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank God for his love and provision of a mother for us. (If a mother is unavailable, thank God for those who show love to us as a mother would.) Thank God for his great love that gave Jesus to die on the cross for our sin.
