This Week's Lesson:

The Spirit Comes at Pentecost

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Jesus sent his Spirit

(Kids Say): God's Spirit lives in me.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Participated in a mystery box presentation of the Bible event.
- Made and ate a "Spirit Fire" snack while reviewing the Bible event.
- Played a game, "Wind Power" and connected it to the power of the Spirit.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Used a hair dryer and ping pong ball to illustrate the unseen Holy Spirit's power in the lives of believers.
- Made a windsock to remind us that the Holy Spirit makes us active in service.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Spirit Comes at Pentecost, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Acts 2:1-14, 38-41.

JESUS LINK: Jesus sends the Holy Spirit who fills me with faith.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- I wonder how Jesus' followers felt after the Spirit came?
- After the Spirit came at Pentecost, how were the believers changed? How was the church changed?
- Jesus promises to give us his Spirit also. How does that change us?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for promising to give you his Spirit. Ask him to fill you with his Spirit and help you to have faith and be bold in living for him.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Have a birthday party for the Christian church. Light a candle on a cake and sing, "Happy Birthday" to the church. Thank Jesus for starting or "giving birth" to the church by sending his Spirit. Make "birthday cards" by drawing pictures of ways you want the Spirit to help you live for Jesus. End by blowing bubbles outside.

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
