DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Listened to a dramatized Ethiopian character tell the story of the Ethiopian coming to faith.
- Made and ate a tortilla scroll as a review of the Bible event.
- Made and played a concentration game to practice teaching others about Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Made a rainbow with M&Ms to help tell the "Good News" to others.
- Played "Pass the Scroll" relay to illustrate telling others about Jesus.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

An Ethiopian Believes, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Acts 8:26-40.

JESUS LINK: All of God's word teaches us Jesus is the Savior.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did Philip help the Ethiopian?
- What can we teach others about Jesus?
- Who can you teach about Jesus?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for being the Savior and for giving his Word so you can know about him. Ask Jesus to help you teach other people about him. Pray for someone who does not yet love and trust in Jesus.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Give your child an opportunity to practice telling the story of Jesus by "reading" a Bible picture book to you. Encourage your child to teach friends and others about Jesus. Let your child see you modeling this behavior as you talk about your faith to others.
