## **This Week's Lesson:**

Elijah is Taken to Heaven in a Fiery Chariot

## **Take Home Point:**

(Parents Say): God is awesome.

(Kids Say): God shows me his power.

### **DRIVE TIME HOME**

#### **PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.**

- Watched a video about God taking Elijah to heaven in a fiery chariot.
- Made and ate a "Fiery Chariot."
- Played a game, "Cloak, Cloak, Who's Got the Cloak?"

### **DRIVE TIME HOME**

#### **PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KIDS CHURCH.**

- Ate Honey Comb cereal to remind us of Chariot wheels.
- Played with play dough to make horses and chariots.
- Made paper puppets and reviewed the story of Elisha and Elijah.

### **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

Elijah is Taken to Heaven in a Fiery Chariot, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 2 Kings 2:1-18.

### **JESUS LINK:**

Just as Elijah was taken to heaven, someday Jesus will take me to heaven.

### **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- How did God show his power through Elijah and Elisha?
- How does God show me his power?
- What was the best thing Jesus did to show us his power?

### **PRAYER POWER:**

Thank God for the ways God has showed his power in your lives.

### **FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:**

Have an arm wrestling contest. Our arms are powerful. Have a contest by seeing who can kick a ball the farthest. Our legs are powerful. How high can your child count? Our brains are powerful. But the greatest power of all is the power of God. The greatest way God showed his power was by coming to earth as Jesus, dying on the cross then rising again on Easter so that someday he can take us to heaven.
