This Week's Lesson:

God Calls Samuel

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): I am God's child.

(Kids Say): I listen to God's word.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Acted out the story of God calling Samuel.
- Listened to Rice Krispies before eating them as a reminder to listen to God's word.
- Played a game, "Whisper, Whisper" to learn about listening carefully to God's word.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Puppets told Samuel's story.
- Made paper cup headphones.
- Played a version of "Marco Polo" to pretend to hear God's calling.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

God calls Samuel, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 1 Samuel 3:1-4:1.

JESUS LINK:

The best thing God's Word tells me is that Jesus came to save me.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What did God tell Samuel after he called him?
- What does God's word tell us?
- How can we listen to God's word?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask God to help you listen to his word. Thank him for the wonderful things his word teaches you, especially the news that Jesus died so your sins can be forgiven.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Make and decorate bookmarks with the words "I listen to God's word" printed on them. Put the bookmarks in favorite Bibles and Bible storybooks and make a practice of using them.
